## THROUGH AIR ( HELICOPTER )

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*Everest Base Camp Helicopter Tour: M.T. Everest*

### 1. Everest Base Camp Helicopter (10 days) - Buckle up, adventure seekers!

Here's the best option for tricking those who want to reach Everest base camp and immerse themselves in the breathtaking natural beauty of the journey.

This Everest base camp helicopter tour package goes through the classical trekking path, reaching Everest base camp in a planned and safe way. Your adventure starts with a flight from Kathmandu to Lukla. Then, you'll embark on a thrilling trek to Phakding, Namche, Tangboche, Dingboche, Lobuche, and finally, Gorakshep. Well, following the path from Gorakshep, you will reach Everest Base Camp on the eighth day. Staying the night at Gorakshep, then tomorrow will be the special part of the tour, the famous view of Kala Patthar viewpoint, which leads to a beautiful and stunning view of Mount Everest and the mountains surrounding Everest, which makes your trek worth it. After the view, you'll be flying back to Lukla from Kala Patthar, which is near Gorakshep. And on the tenth day, you'll be back in Kathmandu.

As this trek includes a high-demand budget so this trekking is recommended for Trakkers who are looking for luxury and quality stay. We will gain high-quality accommodation in all trick stay of 10 day. The beauty of this package is that you will view Mount Everest head-to-head with luxury.

## 2. Everest Base Camp Helicopter (5 days) - Buckle up, adventure seekers!

A secondary option for you to reach Mount Everest and immerse yourself in nature with stunning natural beauty on the way.

This offer of five-day packages imposes certain limitations on your expedition to the Mount Everest base camp. Here you will be staying only four nights as your entire trekking adventure is planned. Whereas you have enough time to explore and enjoy the view from Phakding and Namche whereas you might miss the classical way to Mount Everest's viewpoint.

If you're looking for a break from your daily routine, this is the perfect package for you. You can either make your daily board routine exciting, making this offer a great choice for you. As the helicopter flies to Everest base camp/Kala Patthar nearest viewpoint, you will enjoy your four-day accommodation at Hotel 8848. From where you have the luxury of the view of Mount Everest's first reflection in your windows. Making this stay an Everlasting memory for all of you guys.

As usual you will start your journey from a flight to Lukla from Kathmandu and will reach phakding with in a day you will reach Namche, famous for being the main gateway to Everest Base Camp and the heart of the Sherpa culture making you experience local Sherpas' culture. Well this all expedition will be yours for everest base camp helicopter 5 day package. And on the fifth day, you will return to Kathmandu.

## 3. Everest Base Camp Helicopter Tour (1 Day)

Are you exhausted from your daily routine of work? Here we have the best gift for you. A one-day package for nature lovers who have less time but bigger expectations, with something big to happen. This package might make your boring work spark a bit of energy.

The package starts early in the morning at around 6 o'clock as you leave on a helicopter from Kathmandu. The helicopter will directly make its way to Lukla for a short break for tourists and, more importantly, for a refill. Then it's time for you to take the nearest viewpoint of Mount Everest, the Everest Base Camp Kala Patthar. Here you will have a chance to explore these surroundings, capture a beautiful memory, and then reach Hotel8488 for breakfast. After that, you will head back to Lukle from Kala Patthar for a short break, and finally, you will return to Kathmandu.

This is a beautiful package for those who are seeking a short break from their daily work. You will have an opportunity to get a bird's-eye view. In contrast, you will miss the experience of local Sherpa towns, trekking, and other highlights such as local monasteries, the climate, and flora and fauna in this region.

## ON FOOT (TREKKING)

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*Everest Base Camp on foot Tour: M.T. Everest*

### 1. Everest Base Camp on foot (14 days) - this is an epic adventure!

If you're a nature lover, this package is perfect for you. It includes the classic way to reach the base camp of Mount Everest. Also, this comes under the most selling package with a high satisfying rate. So, if you want to immerse yourself in the nature and beauty of Mount Everest, this package will surely take your eye.

Your journey will start when you take your flight to Lukla from Kathmandu and, following the route, we proceed to Phakding, Namche, Tangboche, Dingboche, Lobuche, and finally reach Gorakshep, the nearest settlement to Everest Base Camp. All your belongings are kept safe at Gorakshep, and you reach Everest Base Camp on your eighth day of the expedition. As you will be returning to Gorakshep to spend a night, on the ninth day, you will get to Kala Patthar, where you will overlook Mount Everest and its other sky-touching mountains surrounding it, from the nearest viewpoint. After reaching Everest, you will mostly be retracing your way back to Namche and finally to Lukla, from where you will head back to Kathmandu.

Going to high altitude too quickly means your body doesn't get enough time to adjust to the lower oxygen levels. So to avoid altitude, you will first stay at Namche Bazaar and then you will head to Dingboche. Where your body will have some time to adjust high altitude and you to explore the Sherpa community.

## 2. Everest Base Camp on foot (15 days) - this is an epic adventure!

This package lets you travel by bus instead of flying, but you'll still get to see the amazing view of Mount Everest. You'll reach the base camp on the eighth day of your trip. But you will be flying to Kathmandu from Lukla.

When you take your bus from Kathmandu, you will first head to Phaplu, which takes around 11 hours of travelling by bus. You will spend a night in Phaplu and then take another bus to Thame Danda, following the path of Everest Base Camp. After you reach Thame Danda, your trek starts to pay off, finally reaching Phakding on the third day. Then, you will follow the classical way to Mount Everest.

Including Phakding, you will head to Namche and then to Deboche, Tengboche, Dingboche, Lobuche, and Gorakshep following the classical way to Mount Everest. As you reach Gorakshep, you will leave your belongings and start climbing to Everest Base Camp. Again, you will head back to Gorakshep to spend a night. Then, the following morning, you will have a beautiful reflection of Mount Everest in your eyes. This makes your journey in reverse to Pheriche and ultimately to Lukla. On the last day of your trek, you will fly from Lukla to Kathmandu.

You will witness the soft and gradual change of the mountain range and geography of Nepal. And have a chance to know about the Sherpa culture, how people make their day in the high mountains. This might be a beautiful trip, making you lean towards nature.

## 3. Everest Base Camp on foot (17 days) - this is an epic adventure!

If you are an international tourist, this package is best for you because it provides you with enough time to relax and also some time to learn more about Kathmandu valley, where you will experience the core hospitality of Nepal. Before starting the trek, we will first start our journey by visiting different heritage sites listed as national as well as world heritage sites. chill time, culture hits, and real Nepali vibes before we hit the trail!

After a day in Kathmandu, you have to take a flight to Lukla from Kathmandu. When you reach the classical flow to Everest base camp, your true trek starts. You will progress from Phakding to Namche, then to Tangboche, Dingboche, Lobuche, and finally to Gorakshep. As you reach Gorakshep, you will start climbing to Mount Everest camp and again return to Gorakshep. Your morning is going to be special, so please get a good night's sleep. Tomorrow morning, you will see a stunning view of Mount Everest's golden reflection of the morning sun rise, which will make all your efforts worth it.
